The NOAMA Board is pleased to announce a call for proposals for the Clinical Innovation Opportunities Fund. This grant funding opportunity is separate and distinct from the existing AHSC AFP Innovation Funds.

#### Background Information:

The intent of the Clinical Innovation Opportunities Fund is to support **<u>physician clinical faculty</u>** in the development and implementation of new evidence based enhancements within their clinical practices which positively impact direct patient care.

Northern physicians are committed to patient care. This Clinical Innovation Opportunities Funding provides you with the opportunity to further explore and implement changes which can ultimately be shared.

#### Grant Information:

From 2013 to 2023, several of your Northern Ontario colleagues applied for Clinical Innovation Opportunities Funding. To date NOAMA has approved 267 projects allocating ~\$12.8 million in funding. For a complete list of funded projects, please click <u>here</u>.

The principal investigator(s), as well as any physician receiving payments under the Clinical Innovation Opportunities Fund project, must be a participating physician in the NOAMA AFP.

The principal investigator <u>and</u> co-investigator(s) on the project application <u>must</u> be compliant with the local guidelines and application process of any outstanding NOAMA (AFP & CIOF) projects.
